Chula Vista Educators met with the District today to negotiate our successor agreement. Check out cveducators.org for the actual proposals. Here are the articles we discussed today.

CVE:

- **Article 8: Hours**
 - Modification to TK and Kinder schedules for safety
 - 1st prep day meeting free, ½ of the others shared
 - DI collab time- district paid
- **MOU Temporary Teachers:**
 - Temp teachers are able to engage in the transfer process in June before outside hires are considered.
- **Article 14: Safety**
 - Language outlining discipline procedures from SDCOE
 - Natural Disaster Language
 - Parameters around parent and community member (advocate) observations

CVESD:

- **Article 14: Safety**
 - Student Discipline to follow board policy and Ed Code
 - Provide training
 - Provide teacher of record and VAPA with student records regarding behaviors
 - Parameters around parent observations
- **Article 33: Transfer**
 - Members on an improvement plan cannot transfer
 - Enrollment projections will be shared with CVE as they are available

Article 10.3.1 Individual Class Size

The Association and the District agree that there is a maximum class size of thirty-one (31) pupils per class. This includes all areas during instructional time with unit members, including field trips and on or off campus academic activities.
