

### **CVE Bargaining Update**

November 16, 2023

Chula Vista Educators met with the District today to negotiate our successor agreement. Check out <a href="mailto:cveducators.org">cveducators.org</a> for the actual proposals. Here are the articles we discussed today.

#### CVE:


- Article 52: Wages
  - CVE proposed an 8% salary increase effective July 2023.
  - CVE proposed a 3% salary increase effective January 2024.
  - CVE proposed a 3% salary increase effective April 2024.
  - CVE proposed all COLA for 23-24 estimated at 3.94% with language for reopening if COLA is greater.
  - Stipends: LSH (\$1500), SPED (\$3000), DI (\$2000), Combo (\$1500) (Equivalent to 1%)
- Article 51: Health
  - CVE proposed a \$1,000 raise to the health care cap bringing it to \$16,000. (Equivalent to 1%)
- Article 8: Hours
  - CVE put back in language:
    - Protecting members from after school meetings and activities
    - Minimum days for the first two weeks of school for TK & Kinder to assess and transition students
    - Time for report cards on the Friday before conferences
    - Protecting teacher collaboration time and providing collab time for VAPA
    - Put back in the TK MOU language the District completely struck out last time
- Article 10: Class Size
  - CVE accepted Moderate/Severe and Mild/Moderate trigger language (triggers the additional aide). (Equivalent to 1%)

#### CVESD:

- Article 52: Wages
  - CVESD proposed an 8.5% salary increase effective July 1, 2023.
  - CVESD also proposed contingency language based on next year's projected COLA. This language is not guaranteed and it means they can manipulate their numbers and give us less.
- Article 51: Health
  - CVESD proposed a \$500 raise to the health care cap bringing it to \$15,500.

#### Article 10: Class Size

- CVESD countered Moderate/Severe SDC language. When a classroom goes above 12 students the District will place one additional classroom aide.
- CVESD countered Mild/Moderate SDC language. When a classroom goes above 15 students the District will place one additional classroom aide.
- CVESD countered they will maintain a caseload maximum for SLP's at 55 students with IEPs. When the caseloads go above this number an SLP aide will be provided.




A representative for CVESD called the police on CVE's teacher rally and tried to limit our access to last night's Board Meeting.
