

CVE Bargaining Update

December 6, 2023

Chula Vista Educators met with the District today to negotiate our successor agreement. Check out <u>cveducators.org</u> for the actual proposals. Here are the articles we discussed today.

CVE & CVESD came to an agreements on:

- Article 10: Class Size
 - Moderate/Severe and Mild/Moderate caseload trigger language (triggers the additional aide). (Equivalent to 1%)
 - Upper Grade and Dual Immersion class size and individual workload language to specify the time will be used for individual classroom preparation.
- Article 51: Health
 - \$500 increase on health cap (\$15,500)
- Article 52: Wages
 - CVE proposed a 9% salary increase effective July 2023.
 - CVE proposed a 3% salary increase effective July 2024.
 - Stipends: LSH (\$1500), SPED (\$3000), DI (\$1500), Combo (\$1500) (Equivalent to 1%)

Articles Still on the Table: Article 8, Article 9, Article 14, Article 60

CVE:



- Article 8: Hours
 - CVE proposed language to specify employees only be required to attend no more than 2 evening school programs.
 - CVE stands firm on teachers NOT being responsible for toileting or diapering students.
 - CVE and CVESD agreed if a third prep day is on the calendar at the start of the year, it will be solely for individual prep time.

CVESD:

- Article 8: Hours
 - CVESD proposed TK language that Instructional Aides are responsible for toileting, and the TK teachers will not be **primarily** responsible for toileting or diapering needs of students.
 - CVESD agreed the first two weeks of school for TK and Kindergarten will be minimum days for the purpose of transitioning students and doing one-on-one assessments.
