CVE Proposals:

- **Article 35: Evaluation**

- This article has been years in the making with the E3 process. The proposed evaluation article is designed to shift the culture of teacher evaluation to a growth model that enhances instruction and positively impacts student learning.

- **Articles 60: Community Schools**
